



Language Enrichment Programme for Parent/ Carers- Autumn 2023 Courses

What is the aim of the Language Enrichment Programme?

The aim of the Language Enrichment Programme is to provide useful and practical strategies to support communication development in the home environment.

Who is this programme for?

This programme is for parent/ carers of **early years (0-5)** aged children and parent / carers of **Primary (aged 5-11 years)** aged children who would like to learn how to support their child's communication and language development at home.

What will whole course cover?

- 1) **Early Years Course.** Sessions will focus on early communication development and strategies that will help your child such as: listening, commenting and taking turns. We will learn about different fun activities to help your child such as story telling and singing nursery rhymes. We will also work together to learn how to apply these strategies to our everyday routine, such as the walk to school, washing up and brushing teeth.
- 2) **Primary course** will focus on communication development beyond the sentence level. We will focus on sentence structure, levels of understanding and vocabulary. We will learn about strategies that you can use to support your child's language development in specific activities and in your everyday routine.

What is the structure of the programme?

Parent/ carers will sign up to the Language Enrichment Programme via a Microsoft Form (see below) The Autumn 23 programme will run over 7 weeks and will offer 3 direct 30-45 minute training sessions with Speech and Language Therapist, Ashleigh McKeown. Ashleigh is a Highly Specialist Speech and Language Therapist. She has experience working with children in the early years, primary schools and secondary schools for the NHS, both in mainstream schools and in additional resourced provisions. She also completes diagnostic assessments for children with social communication differences. Ashleigh supports children with a wide range of communication needs and her passion is motivating and empowering those around the child to support their communication.



Week 1/Session1: What is Communication?

This session will provide you with an overview of communication for your child's age group and the important factors. It will also practice strategies that you can practice right away.

Weeks 2 and 3: You will have the chance to practice the activities that you have learnt at home with your child.

Week 4/Session 2: Activities to do at home

This session will provide you with fun activities that you can do at home with your child to support their communication development.

Week 5: You will have the chance to practice the activities that you have learnt at home with your child.

Week 6/Session 3: Language in your everyday routine

This training will provide you with hints and tips to embed communication strategies within your everyday routine.

Week 7: You will go away and practice these strategies within your everyday routine.

Review: We will all come together and **review** our progress and our thoughts on the programme
