- 1) When you read my favourite stories I can join in with words and phrases that appear over and over again.
- 2) I can tell you the missing word or phrase in stories and rhymes that I know really well, such as “Humpty Dumpty sat on a
- 3) I like singing nursery rhymes and songs.
- 4) I can listen and join in when we read books and sing rhymes.
- 5) I can join in with my favourite stories and guess what will happen next.
- 6) I know that stories have beginnings and endings and sometimes I guess how the story will end.
- 7) I can recognise my own name and words that are special to me, like “mummy” and my favourite shops and foods.
- 8) I hold the book the right way up and turn the pages carefully when I look at it on my own.
- 9) I know that the words in the book tell me things and where the words start on the page.
- 10) I use my favourite stories to help me make up my own stories when I am dressing up or using toy people or animals.
