



## Writing Top Ten-Reception

- 1) To have a dominant hand.
- 2) To be able to hold a pencil using the correct grip.
- 3) To be able to talk about what they have drawn/marks they make.
- 4) To be able to use their phonic knowledge to label their marks.
- 5) To be able to form recognisable letters.
- 6) To use phonic knowledge to write captions and short sentences.
- 7) To have a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops when writing a sentence.
- 8) To be able to write a sentence that can be read by themselves and others (phonetically plausible).
- 9) To begin to use irregular common words in their sentences.
- 10) To write on a line, letters formed correctly.
