## **BEAT Instrument and Singing Lessons – Summer Term 2026 (April 26 – July 26)**

If your child is currently having BEAT lessons, a renewal payment will be set up for Summer Term on Arbor on **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> February**. Please email any changes to your child's lessons or cancellations by **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February** to [office@northsidesch.org](mailto:office@northsidesch.org). **All payments must be paid by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March.**

To book new lessons, send an email to [office@northsidesch.org](mailto:office@northsidesch.org) with your child's name, year group, whether you want group or 1-1 lessons, which instrument and the duration of lessons by **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February**. **Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis as available slots are limited.**

### **We offer lesson in: guitar – ukulele – singing – djembe – violin – piano**

For 10 weekly 1 to 1 lessons the prices are £110 (15 minute lessons), £146 (20 minute lessons) or £215 (30 minute lessons). The lessons take place throughout the school day.

### **We offer ten 30 minute Group Lessons, which take place at lunchtime in**

Djembe (years 4-6) - £43 with a minimum of 5 pupils. The cost will increase if there are less pupils.

Singing (Years 1-3) - £43

Violin (Years 4-6) - £43

As BEAT organise the contracts for all their teachers well in advance payments must be made on Arbor by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March** and refunds cannot be given. Please be aware that teachers, on occasion, cannot make it to school due to unforeseen emergencies, or illness, however, be assured that the teachers will ensure they make up the lessons. If your child is not in school on the day of their lesson or they forget their instrument these lessons will not be made up.
