Year 3 National Gallery Trip

Year 3 will be visiting the National Gallery in London on **Monday, 15th June**, as part of our art and history learning. During our trip, we will be viewing works by two of Britain's greatest painters: Turner and Constable. We will also explore artworks from the 19th century. Depending on the weather, we will also view the lions in Trafalgar Square, created by the artist Sir Edwin Landseer.

We will leave school at 9:15am and take the Tube to Charing Cross. We will return to school at approximately 2:00pm. However, if the weather is adverse, we may return earlier and eat our packed lunches in school instead.

Children will need to wear full school uniform and be dressed appropriately for the weather (e.g. raincoat or sun cream). They will also need to bring a packed lunch (**please note: no nut products or products containing nuts**), as well as a water bottle. All items should be carried in a bag that they can manage themselves throughout the day.
