

Home Learning Activities

Please look through the activities below and choose ones that interest you most! There is no expectation to complete every task, simply have a go at any activities you enjoy. You can complete as many or as few as you like.

Maths - Place Value to 100

- Go on a number hunt around your home. Record the different numbers you find (on clocks, packaging etc.)
- Write 5 two-digit numbers and circle the tens digit.
- Practise counting forwards and backwards from a number between 0 and 100.
- Ask an adult to say a number and tell them one more and one less.
- Play "Guess My Number" with clues such as:
 - It has 6 tens.
 - It has more than 40 but less than 50.

English - The Dark

- Draw a picture of the dark and write 3 words to describe it.
- Tell the story to someone at home in your own words.
- Write a sentence about something you are brave enough to do.
- Find a cosy place to read a book with an adult and talk about your favourite part of a story.
- Write sentences describing the picture:



Phonics:

Read your phonics book or a favourite book for 10 minutes.

- Write a list of as many words with the split digraph a-e.
- Go on a sound hunt and find objects containing this terms phonics sounds.
 - /ai/ sound: eigh aigh ey ea e

- /n/ sound: kn gn
- m/ sound: mb
- /ear/ sound: ere eer
- /zh/ sound: su si
- /j/ sound: dge
- /i/ sound: y
- /j/ sound: ge
- /sh/ sound: ti ssi si ci
- /or/ sound: augh our oar ore
- Write a sentence using a tricky word from this term:
 - Busy, beautiful, pretty, hour, move, improve, parents, shoe

Handwriting

- Practise writing your name and surname neatly three times.
- Copy a favourite sentence from a book using your best handwriting.
- Write the alphabet in lower-case letters.
- Practice writing squiggly lines, diagonal lines and zig zag lines like how we have learnt in class!

DT - Playground Models

Draw your dream playground and label the equipment.

Build a small playground using lego, blocks, toys, recycling materials, or household objects.

Talk to an adult about playground safety and make a list of safety rules.

Invent your own piece of playground equipment, draw it and explain how it works.

Science - Seasons

- Spend 10 minutes outside and record the weather.
- Draw a tree and show what it looks like in the current season.
- Create a weather diary for 3 days.
- Find 5 signs that tell us which season we are in.

Geography - Maps

- Draw a simple map of your bedroom or home.
- Make a treasure map with a key.
- Give directions from one room in your home to another.

- Create a map of your garden, local park, or a made-up island.

Other:

- Family Interview. Ask a family member:
 - What was school like when they were young?
 - What games did they play?
 - What was their favourite childhood memory?
- Complete one act of kindness each day and record it with pictures or words.
- Drink plenty of water.
- Spend time reading in a cool place.
- Create a sun-safety poster.
- Design a hat for hot weather.
- Keep a weather chart for the week.
