Dear Resident,

Following the consultation exercises undertaken between 28 November 2024 and 23 January 2025, we are writing to inform you that we are implementing proposed new measures on Lodge Lane, N12. Having reviewed all comments and objections received to the consultation the council has decided to proceed with some modifications to our original proposals.

The scheme incorporates the following engineering measures on Lodge Lane:

1. **Redesign of junction with High Road** – introduction of a raised entry table, footway surface improvements, and public cycle parking facilities.
2. **Redesign of Lodge Lane at its junction with Gainsborough Road** – provision of footway build-outs, junction realignment, and surface improvements.
3. **Introduction of vertical traffic-calming features** in the form of sinusoidal road humps and raised tables to encourage lower vehicle speeds and promote safer driver behaviour.
4. **Redesign of the parking layout** to achieve a more rational and safer use of available kerbside space, whilst minimising any impact on on-street parking provision for residents.
5. **Enhancement of key pedestrian crossing points** along Lodge Lane to improve accessibility and pedestrian safety.
6. **Introduction of road markings and signage** as complementary measures to support and reinforce the core highway improvements.

We have taken into consideration and reviewed all comments and objections received, in accordance with the consultation regulations. We have thoroughly assessed the potential impact of the proposed measures on the community and recommend that it would be appropriate to proceed with the installation of the measures outlined above.

The works are scheduled to commence, weather permitting, on 18 July 2026.

Please be aware that it may be necessary to temporarily prohibit parking on stretches of the road during the works and we kindly ask residents to refrain from parking in areas where parking suspensions have been put in place. We will provide access to and from adjoining roads and driveways. Pedestrian and emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Please ask members of staff on site to assist you if you require access. We appreciate residents' co-operation in enabling the works to go ahead and apologise for any inconvenience caused during this time.

Important information regarding these works:

- Works are to be undertaken by the Council's Term Maintenance contractor Tarmac Kier (TKJV). The contractor's normal working pattern is Monday – Friday. Work may be required to be carried out at weekends to ensure completion of works during school summer holidays.
- The works will entail the contractor working up and down the road in sections. During this period access will be maintained for residents to their property.
- During the works, residents may not be able to park in their normal place. To minimise disruption, the Council can provide a temporary parking permit on a short-term basis.
- Any cars that are parked within the prohibited parking area, during the works, will be lifted to a nearby road.
- To apply for a temporary permit, please contact us by email quoting the reference number on this letter and the name of your road to highwayscorrespondence@barnet.gov.uk or by telephone 020 8359 3555, up to one week prior to work commencing onsite.
- Information required to apply for a temporary permit: property number and road name, vehicle registration number, the registered keeper/ driver(s) name, the Controlled Parking Zone code.
