What are SATs?

Standard Assessment Tests

- English – SPaG (Mon)-grammar, punctuation & spelling
- Reading (Tues)
- Writing (not in SATs week) teacher assessments which include handwriting.
- Maths – (Wed & Thurs) including arithmetic and 2 reasoning papers
- **Science**

Most children are expected to reach Year 6 age related expectations.

Attendance

- Exams will start at 9.30 at the latest.
- All children **must** be in school, **for every exam** and they need to be on time.
