


Music Theory Quiz 2

- How long does a crotchet rest last for? **1 beat**
- Is there such a thing as a semi-quaver rest? Circle the correct answer.

- Which rest do we use in a bar without any notes, no matter what the key signature is? **Semibreve rest**
- What is a tie? Explain your answer in full sentences.
In music notation, a tie is a curved line connecting the heads of two notes of the same pitch, indicating that they are to be played as a single note with a duration equal to the sum of the individual notes' value
- What is the main difference between a tie and a slur? Explain your answer in full sentences.
The difference is a tie connects two notes of the same pitch (on the same line or space of the staff). A slur applies to two or more different notes and means the two different notes should be played legato (smoothly).
- How long does a dotted minim last for? **2 beats**
- How long does a dotted crotchet last for? **1 ½ /1.5 beats**
- Match up the note with its equivalent rest. (2 marks)
